

What does "glory" look like? Is it a triumphant general after a decisive victory? Or the MVP after a championship-winning performance? In today's Gospel, which takes place during the Last Supper, Jesus suggests that God's glory looks a little different: it looks like someone offering themselves so another can have life. This is, after all, what Jesus will do shortly after the Last Supper, when he offers His life on the cross for all mankind. This, he tells us, is how God is glorified. And he makes the point even more clear when he tells those present that having love for one another is the truest sign that they are his disciples, that they are partaking in His glory. So what does it look like for us to participate in God's glory? It means giving of ourselves at home, to our spouse and children, friends and family. It means giving of ourselves in our local community, volunteering and serving others. And it also means offering ourselves to build up our local Church. One important way we can do this right now is by supporting our Annual Diocesan Appeal. Ask God how you can glorify Him through your contribution, and give today.
