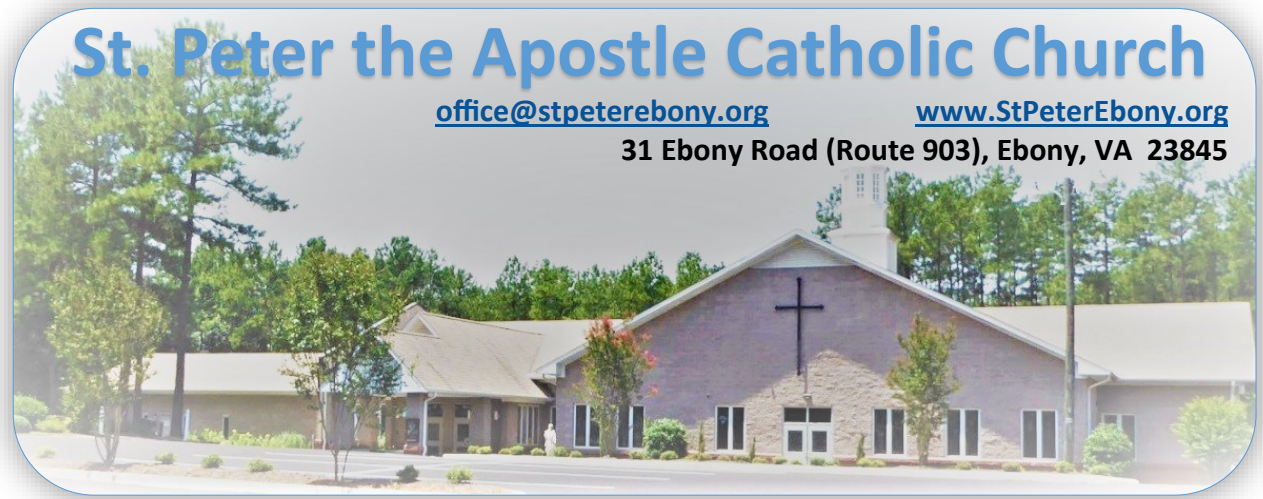

## Study of the Readings

### Focusing the Gospel

**Key words & phrases:** Spirit of truth, all truth, glorify me, Everything that the Father has, declare it to you

**To the point:** The Spirit guides us to all truth. Such a bold statement! That truth is the Holy Spirit, is the Life given by the Spirit. Everything the Father has is given us. An even bolder statement! What the Father gives us is divine Life. And it is for Jesus' glory

that his disciples are and even to "boast of our empowered by the Spirit to afflictions"

bear what belongs to Jesus ... **to experience:** Our age and the Father: divine Life. has an inherent optimism Our triune God holds back about unraveling the mysteries of life, whether it be nothing from us. the origins of the universe or the genetic makeup of a person. If there's a mystery, "we'll solve it." This solemnity presents the Trinity as a mystery not to be "solved" or "explained," but as a Trinity of Persons who share their very Life with us.

### Connecting the Gospel ...

**... to the Second Reading:** Since we have received everything that is of God, the Trinity's divine life is within us (see Gospel). This life "poured . . . into our hearts" empowers us to be justified

The diocesan approach to COVID-19 guidance regarding Mass and liturgical gatherings has shifted from state-wide mandates to localized "Community Level" recommendations to best manage the spread of the virus. This new approach encourages pastors to create, implement, and continually reevaluate local plans to best meet the needs of their community. In this approach, the Diocese provides overall COVID-19 guidance, based upon the latest recommendations from the CDC and VDH, and then parishes are encouraged to adapt these to their local circumstances.

Based on the latest CDC and VDH Guidance, there are three potential **Community Levels** for each county – "**Low**", "**Medium**", or "**High**".

Here are the three levels with corresponding Diocesan Recommendations:

#### **COMMUNITY LEVEL: LOW OR HIGH**

Masks are welcome at the discretion of the individual

#### **COMMUNITY LEVEL: HIGH**

One should wear a mask. Gatherings are allowed as in socials after Mass.
