

# **PARISH NEWS**

The diocesan approach to COVID-19 guidance regarding Mass and liturgical gatherings has shifted from state-wide mandates to localized "Community Level" recommendations to best manage the spread of the virus. This new approach encourages pastors to create, implement, and continually reevaluate local plans to best meet the needs of their community. In this approach, the Diocese provides overall COVID-19 guidance, based upon the latest recommendations from the CDC and VDH, and then parishes are encouraged to adapt these to their local circumstances.

Based on the latest CDC and VDH Guidance, there are three potential Community Levels for each county - "Low", "Medium", or "High".

Here are the three levels with corresponding Diocesan

Recommendations: COMMUNITY LEVEL: LOW OR HIGH

Masks are welcome at the discretion of the individual

One should wear a mask. Gatherings are allowed as in socials after Mass.
