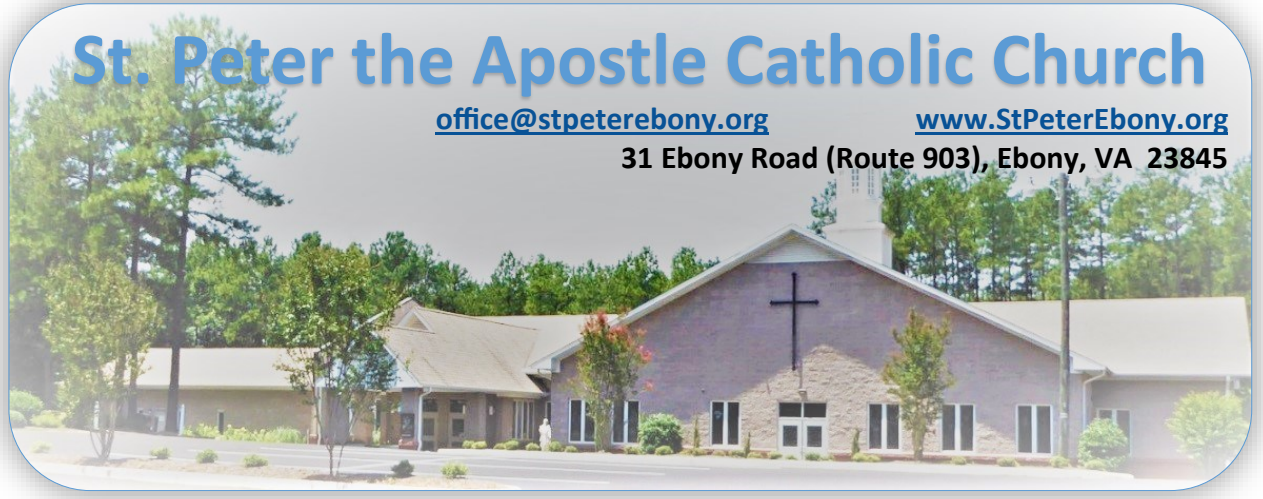

#### Key words & phrases:

I have come, on fire, I must be baptized, anguish until it is accomplished.
