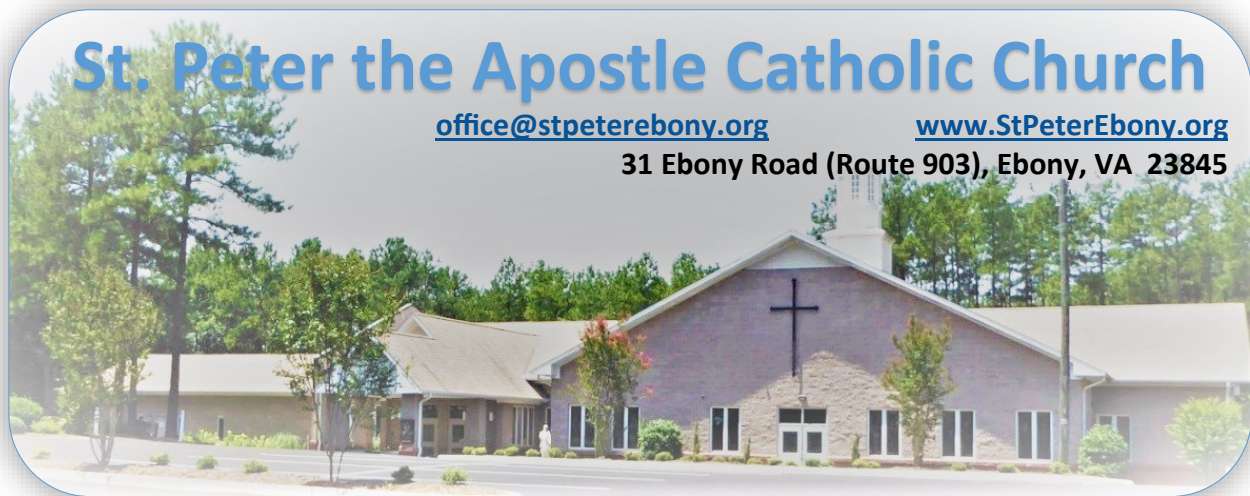

Jesus tells the parable of the proud Pharisee who prayed from his self-importance and the tax collector who prayed humbly.

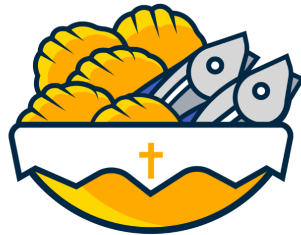
