

Focusing the Gospel Kev words & phrases:

The kingdom of heaven is like, Do you want us to, when fullgrown, leavened, what has lain hidden, children of the kingdom, end of the age

To the point: "The kingdom of heaven is like ... " Jesus uses three comparisons to explain this mystery of God's Presence and reign. The first parable speaks of discernment: the second of full third growth; the transformation. In this is the realization of the kingdom of


