

If we read Matthew's entire Gospel we would read about Jesus' debate with the Pharisees about Jewish purity laws. Jesus argues that it is not what goes into us that makes us unclean, referring to the strict Jewish dietary rules. Instead our words and actions-what comes out of us-make us unclean because they emerge from a heart that is unclean.
