

In today's parable, Jesus offers ar image of the kingdom of heaven using the symbol of a wedding banquet. Jesus' listeners would have been familiar with the image of a wedding feast as a symbol for God's salvation. They would consider themselves to be the invited guests. The king dispatches his servants to invite the quests to the wedding feast. The listeners would have been surprised to learn that the first quests refused the invitation. Who would refuse the king's invitation? A second dispatch of servants follows. Again to the listeners' great surprise, some guests ignore the invitation. Some of
