



Background on the Gospel **Reading** Mark 1:12-15

On the first Sunday of Lent, the Gospel reading is about Jesus temptation in the desert. Compared to the Gospels of Matthew and Luke, details throughout Mark's narrative are sparse. Mark tells us only that Jesus was led into the desert by the Spirit and that for 40 days he was tempted by Satan. Jesus' temptation follows his baptism by John the Baptist. Jesus went into the desert immediately after his baptism, led by the Spirit. Jesus' public ministry in Galilee begins after his temptation in the desert.
