

## Easter Sunday of the Resurrection of the Lord—March 31, 2024

Study of the Readings

### Background on the Gospel Reading John 20:1-9

Today we begin the Easter Season our 50-day meditation on the mystery of Christ's Resurrection. Our Gospel today tells us about the disciples' discovery of the empty tomb. It concludes by telling us that they did not yet understand that Jesus had risen from the dead. Thus, the details provided are not necessarily meant to offer proof of the Resurrection. The details invite us to reflect upon a most amazing gift, that is faith in Jesus and his Resurrection. Jesus' empty tomb was first discovered by women. This is notable because in first-century Jewish society women could not serve as legal witnesses. In John's Gospel, the

only woman attending the tomb is that Jesus' body had not been stolen (it Mary of Magdala.
