

Background on the Gospel **Reading** Mark 16:15-20

Today's Gospel is taken from the conclusion of the Gospel of Mark. Scholars have noted irregularities about the ending of Mark's Gospel. There is a natural break in the story line at verse 8, when Mark's report of the discovery of the empty tomb comes to an abrupt conclusion. This verse reports that the women were so frightened by what they had seen at the tomb that they told no one. This may be the original ending of Mark's Gospel, or the more complete ending has been lost. manuscripts of Mark's Gospel, written between the fourth and ninth centuries, include what scholars have termed the Shorter Ending. This ending indicates that the women told their story to Peter's

writings of the early Church Fathers, and it was accepted at the Council of Trent as part of the canonical Gospel of Mark. Jesus assigns his disciples the task of proclaiming the gospel message to the entire world, and the disciples are sent by Jesus to baptize and to preach. The Gospel of Mark reports Jesus' ascension into heaven and that Jesus ascended to sit at the right hand of God.
