

Study of the Readings

Background on the Gospel **Reading** Matthew 28:16-20

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. This feast invites us to consider what we believe about God, who has revealed himself to us in the Trinity, one God in three Persons. Today's Gospel is from the Gospel of Matthew. In its conclusion, Matthew's Gospel quickly moves from the disciples' discovery of Jesus' empty tomb and Jesus' appearance to Mary Magdalene and the other Mary to the commission that Jesus gives to his disciples. The final commission. as this part of Matthew's Gospel is called, is given on the mountaintop. Throughout Scripture, many important events happen on a mountaintop, and

earlier, the Twelve were sent only to God's love.
