

Background on the Gospel **Reading** Mark 10:17-30

A man approaches Jesus inquiring about what he must do to inherit eternal life. Jesus replies that one must follow the commandments. The man acknowledges that he has observed all of these since his childhood. Jesus then says that one thing is lacking: he must give his possessions to the poor and follow Jesus. The man leaves in sadness because he had many possessions. The belief in resurrection and eternal life was a relatively recent development in Jewish thought at Jesus' time, and it wasn't shared by everyone. The Pharisees taught there would be a resurrection from the dead; the Sadducees did not share this belief Jesus taught that there would be a final
