

The theme of faith takes center stage during the Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time. Hebrews 11, often called the "Hall of Faith," highlights the lives of people like Abraham and Sarah, whose faith was not just intellectual belief but action. Their stories remind us that true faith involves both believing God's promises and entrusting ourselves to him through action. Abraham's life is a prime example: He believed God's call to leave his homeland, but he didn't stop there—he acted on that belief, journeying to an
